First-degree burn:

It takes 3-6 days as healing time without scarring.

Second-degree burn (superficial):

A topical agent with cleaning and sterile dressing.

Healing time is 7-21 days.

Deep-partial thickness (deep second degree):

Cleaning along with topical agent and a sterile dressing is preferred.

There is a possibility of surgical excision as well as grafting.

Third-degree (full thickness):

Surgical excision as well as grafting.

Fourth degree:

Surgical intervention is required for healing.

Fluid resuscitation is another way of treatment.




Figure 1: Treatments for burn patients



Figure 2: The Nile tilapia skin used as xenograft for skin grafting in burn patient [34].




Figure 3: Conceptual design of bacteria based microrobot which consist of microstructure, anticancer drug and motile bacteria as microactuator [39].
